Who We Are

How We May Contact You

If we need to contact you regarding the London Marathon, we will do so by telephone or in writing to the email or postal address you have provided. All use of your personal data will be in accordance with our Privacy Policy, including the sharing of your data with London Marathon Events (the event organiser) where applicable.

Event Details

Organiser: The London Marathon is organised and operated by London Marathon Events.

Where any conflict arises between Child.org's terms and those of London Marathon Events, Child.org's terms will take precedence in respect of your fundraising obligations, and London Marathon Events' terms will take precedence in respect of your participation in the marathon itself.

Your Participation

Registration Fee

The registration fee for this challenge is £100, payable to Child.org at the point of registration to confirm your place. This fee must be paid within one week of receiving your offer of a place. All registration fees are strictly non-refundable.

Place Transfers

Your marathon entry is strictly personal to you. You are not permitted to transfer your charity place to another runner.

Fundraising Pledge & Milestones

We ask that you pledge to raise a minimum of £2,500 (excluding Gift Aid and any registration fee) in sponsorship. We encourage you to raise as much as possible to support our work championing maternal and newborn health in Kenya. To keep your fundraising on track, the following minimum amounts must be raised by the dates shown:

- £500 raised by 30 November
- £1,500 raised by 28 February
- £2,000 raised no later than two weeks before the event

If you are struggling to meet a milestone, please contact us as early as possible - we are here to help. Continued failure to meet milestones may result in your place being withdrawn at Child.org's discretion, and we will contact you to discuss your situation before any such decision is taken.

You may collect sponsorship money in any manner you wish, including via a fundraising platform. Where funds have been collected by you personally, these must be paid in full to Child.org within one month of the conclusion of the London Marathon. Please contact the Child.org team to arrange payment.

Age Requirement

The minimum age to participate in the London Marathon is 18 years old.

Code of Conduct

You must adhere to all rules and guidelines set by London Marathon Events. If your conduct is deemed unsafe or contrary to the event's guidelines, the organisers reserve the right to remove you from the event.

Changes, Postponement or Cancellation

Cancellation by You

Should you decide not to take your place in the London Marathon, your registration fee will not be refunded. However, if you are unable to participate due to injury or other exceptional circumstances, you may be able to defer your place to the following year's event. Please contact us to discuss your options.

Cancellation or Changes by London Marathon Events

Child.org has no control over the organisation of the London Marathon. London Marathon Events may need to make changes to, postpone, or cancel the event due to circumstances outside their control. Please refer to London

Marathon Events' Terms and Conditions (linked above) for further information. In such circumstances, we will contact you as soon as possible. If the marathon is cancelled or subject to substantial postponement, we will ask whether you wish to transfer your registration to an alternative challenge event. If you do not wish to do so, you may request a refund of your registration fee.

Sponsorship Money

If the marathon is cancelled (and you do not transfer to an alternative event), or if you choose not to participate, you are responsible for contacting your sponsors to inform them and to confirm whether they are happy for any funds already donated to be retained by Child.org. If you are using sponsorship forms, all forms and monies collected must either be forwarded to us or returned to your sponsors in line with their wishes.

Our Liability

Child.org is not the organiser of the London Marathon and accepts no responsibility or liability in respect of the running of the event. Child.org will not be responsible for injury or illness resulting from your participation, nor for any damage or losses outside of our control.

Nothing in these terms limits or excludes our liability where it would be unlawful to do so, including liability for death or personal injury caused by our negligence or that of our employees, agents or subcontractors.

If we fail to comply with these terms, we are responsible for loss or damage you suffer that is a foreseeable result of our breach or our failure to use reasonable care and skill. We are not responsible for any loss or damage that is not foreseeable. Loss or damage is foreseeable where it is obvious it will happen, or where both parties were aware at the time of contracting that it might occur.

Use of Personal Data

You have provided Child.org with personal information, which we will use and share in order to perform this contract. It will be necessary to share your data with London Marathon Events to facilitate your participation in this challenge.

We do not sell or share your details with third parties, except London Marathon Events and service providers authorised to act on our behalf in carrying out our work. We will retain your details on our database in order to provide you with the best possible support.
